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Savage School: Messer worked on a coal application on behalf of Savage Public Schools. With the

information that they sent to her, she was able to complete it, and get it submitted ahead of the 7/29 deadline. She received notice that our application was complete. Messer should receive the staff report by the first of September. She will

then present the application to the coal board on 9/12.

Shot Show: The MT Dept of Commerce reached out and invited Leslie to attend a trade show

in Las Vegas in January 2025. The purpose of the show is to try to recruit ammunition companies to expand to Montana. Leslie asked the Executive Board

their opinion, and all voted in favor of her attending the show.
