Coal Grant Update: Messer connected with the Dept of Commerce & coal board to determine the

pathway to ask for drawdowns for this economic diversification strategy and comprehensive economic strategy grant. She will prepare these documents and

get signatures from the county to proceed.

Request for Proposals: As part of the RC Economic Diversification Strategy and Comprehensive Strategy,

REDC sent out the request for proposals to engineering firms across the state. The

deadline was 5:00 PM on Sept 30, 2024. We received 3 proposals.

Savage School

Coal Board Application: Messer traveled to Billings to make the presentation on behalf of Savage School

for building repairs. Superintendent Martha Potter was in attendance as well. They were thrilled to be awarded the full \$281,000. In addition, Messer was reimbursed by Savage School for all expenses that she incurred: hours, mileage, and hotel

expenses.

Sidney Sugar Update: Director Paul Green contacted Leslie to see if she had connection with the new

owner of the plant. Director Green was curious mainly because of the rail spur. Green wondered if the new owner might be interested in potentials for the property. Leslie contacted Mr. Hansen to determine his willingness to learn more

about the state's opportunities. He stated that he would be interested.

MEDA Conference: Both Leslie and Amelia went to Havre to participate in the fall conference of MEDA.

Leslie introduced Amelia to several connections that she's made over the years. They were educated on the history of Havre and the latest economic projects

there.
